

Please make contact with the classroom teacher to arrange a time.




Breast Cancer Awareness Month Support

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB PAYMENT INFORMATION

For those clubs requiring payment, please use the following banking information to make payments.

NO CASH PAYMENTS WILL BE TAKEN BY THE SCHOOL'S OFFICE OR BY TEACHERS/ FACILITATORS.

Clubs dues should be paid in accordance with the protocol of each club requiring dues.

SICKNESS PROTOCOLS

In order to keep the school a happy and safe working environment for students and staff we ask that sick children remain at home. This includes days where there may be examinations taking place. These can be made up at a later date when the child can perform to the best of his or her ability.

We ask that children with the following symptoms remain at home:

- Fever
- Cough
- Vomiting and diarrhea
- Sore throat
- Body aches or chills.
- Headache not related to dehydration.
- Sinus congestion with thick mucus.

A child who comes to school sick, or who develops symptoms of illness during the school day will be seated safely outside the classroom and a parent or guardian will be called to collect the child.


Additionally please be reminded that children must not come to school with medications in their bags.

If a medication is required this must be prescribed by the child's physician and have a pharmacy label with the name and the dosage written on it.

This includes over the counter medications.


